



Terms & Conditions



The following terms and conditions govern participation in the **Double Draw 'Stres Free' Promotion**. By entering, participants agree to be bound by these Terms, including all eligibility criteria, entry requirements and prize conditions. It is the responsibility of each participant to review and understand these terms prior to participation.

1. Promotional Period

- The promotion begins on April 12th, 2026 and end on June 6th, 2026, unless the decision is made by The Barbados Lottery to extend the promotion beyond those dates.
- Tickets used to enter the promotion are only valid if purchased after April 1st, 2026.

2. Promotion Details

- Customers enter with a minimum of \$20 in non-winning Double Draw tickets.
- Entries must be placed with name and valid contact number in official drop boxes provided.
- The winner will be chosen at random by a representative of The Barbados Lottery.

3. Eligibility

- The promotion is open to players 18 years and older.
- Barbados Lottery employees and their immediate family members who reside with them are NOT eligible to enter.
- A valid government-issued photo identification is required to claim prizes.

4. Prize Description

- Prizes are non-transferable and consist of an allotment towards the following monthly expenses, subject to the specified maximum limits:

- i. Housing: Capped at \$2,000 per month for a total of six (6) months, to be paid via direct deposit into the account of the person whose name is listed on the back of the ticket.
- ii. Utilities: Capped at \$600 per month for a total of six (6) months, to be paid via Sure Pay vouchers.
- iii. Gas: Capped at \$400 per month for a total of six (6) months, to be paid via RUBIS vouchers.
- iv. Groceries: Capped at \$1,000 per month for a total of six (6) months, to be paid via vouchers (Massy Barbados, Popular Discounts, A One Supermarket or Cherish Cosmetique).

5. Voucher Redemption

- Voucher is subject to the expiration date specified by the business that issued it.
- Vouchers cannot be redeemed for cash by The Barbados Lottery.
- Vouchers are only redeemable at participating locations.

6. Prize Conditions

- All prize components are subject to the specified maximum values and will not exceed the specified amounts.
- Any unused portion of the allocated amounts will be forfeited and cannot be carried forward or transferred.

7. General Conditions

- The Barbados Lottery reserves the right to verify the identity and age of all winners and disqualify any entrant who does not meet the eligibility requirements of this promotion.
- By entering, participants agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.
- The Barbados Lottery reserves the right to use winner's names and pictures (still and/or video) in Lottery promotional activities.
- Winner is responsible for any applicable taxes.
- The Barbados Lottery reserves the right to amend, suspend or cancel the promotion in its sole discretion.

Winner Verification

- The Barbados Lottery will review and confirm potential winner information and eligibility prior to declaring an official winner for each prize.
- Verification of all information and eligibility criteria must be established to the sole satisfaction of The Barbados Lottery and its contractor, Brightstar before a potential winner is named an 'Official Winner' or entitled to claim any prize.
- A participant who is selected as a potential winner will be contacted by The Barbados Lottery via telephone to initiate the verification process. The Barbados Lottery will use the contact information provided by the participant at the time of registration to initiate contact by telephone. If the potential winner does not respond after three (3) phone calls, they have 24 hours within which to respond. If no response is received after these attempts, The Barbados Lottery will move to an alternate potential winner.
- A Barbados Lottery representative will speak via telephone with a potential winner to verify their eligibility.

Publicity of Winners

- An official winner's participation in the promotion and acceptance of the prize constitutes the official winner's express permission for The Barbados Lottery to use their name and likeness for advertising and promotional purposes, without compensation.
- This same permission is granted by someone executing the documents necessary to collect the prize on behalf of the official winner who is unable to collect the prize on his or her own behalf. Further, by accepting a prize, each official winner agrees to hold The Barbados Lottery and its agencies, employees, owners, directors, officers, affiliates and contactors, harmless against any and all claims or liability arising out of the official winner's participation in the promotion and receipt and ownership or use of a prize.
- The Barbados Lottery and its agencies, employees, directors, officers, affiliates and contractors, are not responsible for late or incomplete or misdirected participant entries, or for incorrect, inaccurate or incomplete information associated with such entries, even if caused by failures in the entry website or online entry form, or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in this promotion.

APPENDIX A

Brightstar Privacy Statement

- Your privacy is important to us at Brightstar.
- We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it. We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, develop our products, or protect our rights.

Visitors to this website

- Like most Websites, The Barbados Lottery collects non-personally identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request.
- The Barbados Lottery's purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how visitors use its website.
